The first half of the programme celebrates the Italian madrigal's journey to England, acquiring new texts and decorations along the way, with works by Jacques Arcadelt, Melchior Franck, Orlando Gibbons, Giaches de Wert, John Wilbye and others.

The Apostle Peter's abandonment of Jesus is explored in seven sections of **Orlando di Lasso**'s extraordinary psychodramatic madrigal cycle *Lagrime di San Pietro*.

Peter Foggitt's set of miniature madrigals based on Spenser's *Epithalamion* completes the evening.
